



# **INSTALLING THE LEARNLINK SECURITY CERTIFICATE (IOS DEVICES)**

Apple iOS devices - iPhones / iPads / iPod Touch

The LearnLink solution has been designed with a security focus, this includes encrypting data across elements of the DECD environment. To do this, devices within schools and preschools need to install a security certificate called **SAEDU Certificate Authority Root Certificate (SAEDURootCA)**.

This Fact Sheet documents the steps required to manually install the LearnLink security certificate on an iPhone, iPad or iPod Touch. If you already use configuration profiles you can simply add the SAEDU Root CA certificate to your current profiles.

- Connect the iOS device to the Internet.
   Either an internal school WiFi connection or an external 3G mobile connection will work.
- 2. Open Safari



3. Enter <a href="http://ca.schools.sa.edu.au/">http://ca.schools.sa.edu.au/</a> into the address bar and Go.



4. Select the SAEDURootCA.cer link
